- 4. Twenty-five percent of the shares subject to the option vest on May 19, 2024, the first anniversary of the vesting commencement date, and the remainder vests in 36 equal monthly installments thereafter, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service with the Issuer on each respective vesting date.
